

# Tips for bicyclists



## Safety & courtesy for all road users

Dear Bicyclists,

Welcome to the Grossglockner High Alpine Road.

Please obey the following **safety rules**:

- Ride in single file and keep to the right.
- Use caution when driving downhill and do not cut curves. Accelerate to a safe speed.
- Adjust your speed according to the weather conditions (rain, slippery roads, etc.) and your physical fitness level.
- USE CAUTION in CURVES and HAIRPIN CURVES (cars and buses have „blind spots“).
- Wear a reflective safety vest or use reflective strips for extra safety. (Reflecting strips are available at the Piffkar, Fuscher Törl, Hochtör-Süd and Schöneck shops for EUR 2.90 each.)
- If possible, use our road during toll-free times (before 9:00 a.m. and after 3:00 p.m.) when there is less traffic.
